Context

With the largest wave of urbanization in history in the last decade, nearly half of the world's population lives in cities. This is projected to increase further with a major growth in Africa and Asia. At present approximately 340 million Indian's live in nearly 3700 towns and cities spread across the country. This is 30% of the population in contrast to only 60 million (15%) lived in urban areas in 1947. In the past five decades, India's population has grown two and a half times, however urban India has grown by nearly five times. This has created great pressure on the cities and the biggest challenge of "Making Cities Work". Since the past ten years Municipalika has been instrumental in bringing out these challenges and possible solutions for managing cities in a better way.

According to latest reports by ministry of Urban Development, India needs an investment of Rs 39.2 trillion in infrastructure over the next 20 years. In the annual budget Rs 12.14 trillion is allocated to be spent on infrastructure for 2011-2012. Many initiatives are being undertaken by Central, State and Local/City Governments for addressing the urban challenges, the biggest and most ambitious being the Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JNNURM) of the Government of India, which aims at creating economically productive, efficient, equitable, inclusive, sustainable and responsive cities.

Municipalika provides a platform to take stock of the progress, to assess the possibilities and problems, and map future strategies and solutions.

About Tamil Nadu and Chennai

Tamil Nadu is the most urbanized state of India with 54.4% of its population living in urban areas. It is the fifth largest contributor to India's GDP and ranks tenth in Human Development Index. The state has developed several industrial parks / estates that have helped a great deal in industrialization. At present 18 industrial parks, 87 industrial estates of SIDCO and 95 special economic zones are spread all over Tamil Nadu. The state has 10 City Corporations with Chennai being the oldest corporation in India, 152 municipalities and 611 Town Panchayats. Tamil Nadu has been the pioneer state of E- Governance initiatives in India.

Chennai being the fourth most populous city of India, is also one of the fastest growing cities. The city is one of the most preferred destinations for manufacturing and new economy industries with its excellent connectivity, both national as well as international. As an automobile hub, it attracts substantial investments in this sector and allied industries. The economic base is very strong and growing rapidly with development of SEZ's and IT parks. Chennai will be a major growth centre and will attract substantial domestic and foreign direct investments. As it is projected to have a population of over 10 Million by 2030, pressure on urban infrastructure and city development will continue.
